Downtown Revitalization Program South Hill, VA

Large Structure Rehabilitation Incentives

Purpose: To encourage economic development and preservation of old buildings in

the downtown area by supporting the rehabilitation and utilization of large

structures.

Structure Type: Buildings of over 10,000 square feet.

Qualifications: Renovation of large structures located in the targeted Downtown area with

a minimum investment of \$25,000. Investment will be established by evidence provided to the Code Compliance Official at the time of building

permit application.

Commercial buildings must host a business which creates and maintains a minimum of three full-time employment positions for at least one year

which pay at least 125% of the current federal minimum wage.

Residential buildings must have an average occupancy rate during the first

year of at least 33%.

Area: Intersection of Plank Road and West Danville Street east to the

intersection with Mecklenburg Avenue and north on Mecklenburg Avenue

to the intersection with Franklin Street

Incentives: Economic Stimulus Grant – Refund of 50% of the business, professional

and occupations license tax for the first year.

Waiver of building permit fees.

Refund of Water/Sewer connection fees.

Refund of real estate taxes according to the following schedule:

Year 1 - 100%, Year 2 - 50%, Year 3 - 25%.
